Suggested Home Learning

- Put a small plastic toy in a silicone mould or yoghurt pot and fill with water. Freeze overnight. The next day, find ways to melt the ice and release the toy. You could try using salt or warm water.
- In winter the ground is cold and hard. Birds need extra food. Make a bird food cake using the instructions on the RSPB website. Hang the cake outside and list the birds that visit.
- Make snow dough by mixing 2 cups cornflour with 1/3 cup vegetable oil or baby oil and add a sprinkling of glitter. Make a winter scene using the snow dough.
